



Update: Keystone First Formulary Change

- 1) As of March 15, 2017, the following products have been removed from the Keystone First drug formulary**

Members currently receiving any of the products list below will require a new prescription for an alternative product before May 01, 2017. Members for whom it is not medically advisable to change therapy will require prior authorization.

Byetta (exenatide)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Victoza (liraglutide) or Trulicity (dulaglutide)
Prevacid Solutab (lansoprazole)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prilosec suspension (omeprazole), omeprazole capsules, Prevacid 24 Hour, lansoprazole capsules, or Nexium 24 Hour (esomeprazole)
Omeprazole Magnesium 20mg OTC capsules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prilosec suspension (omeprazole), omeprazole capsules, Prevacid 24 Hour, lansoprazole capsules, or Nexium 24 Hour (esomeprazole)

- 2) As of March 15, 2017, all formulary Proton Pump Inhibitors (PPIs) will have a maximum quantity limit of one unit per day (tablet or capsule) without prior authorizations.**

Members currently receiving more than one unit per day for whom it is not medically advisable to change therapy will require prior authorization before June 01, 2017.
