



Update: Formulary Changes Keystone First

Effective September 03, 2018, the following products will be removed from the Keystone First drug formulary.

Members currently receiving any of the products list below will require a new prescription for an alternative product before **October 22, 2018**. Members for whom it is not medically advisable to change therapy will require prior authorization to continue to receive coverage for the non-formulary product.
