Free home delivery to encourage medication adherence!

Often a major barrier to a patient taking their medication is the inability to get to the pharmacy. Keystone First recognizes this access issue and is partnering with network pharmacies to provide free home delivery for Keystone First patients, particularly those that are taking statins, asthma controllers, oral hypoglycemics, or anti-hypertensives.

The pharmacies listed below offer free home delivery (no narcotics are eligible for home delivery):

- Providers can call to request home delivery for Keystone First members. Choose the prompt to speak with a pharmacist – do not leave a message.
- Current prescriptions can be transferred from other pharmacies; Neighborcare will handle the transfer details
