Dear Keystone First Primary Care Provider,

Keystone First is making the following changes to the Quality Enhancement Program (QEP) for the 2023 Program.

The Quality Performance component will now consist of the following eight HEDIS® based measures:

- Child and Adolescent Well Care Visits [ages 3-21] (WCV)
- Asthma Medication Ratio
- Plan All Cause Readmission – Count of Expected/Observed Ratio
- Well Child visits in the First 30 Months of Life (ages 0-15mo)
- Lead Screening for Children
- Controlling High Blood Pressure <140/90 mm Hg
- Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life
- Hemoglobin A1c Control for Patients with Diabetes (>9%) (HBD)

Existing Performance Components:

1. **Total Cost of Care Component** (this component will only include non-Pediatric practices/groups)
2. **Top Performer Component** (this component will only include Pediatric practices/groups)
3. **Health Equity Component**
4. **Electronic Submission of CQM**
5. **Improvement Component**


An updated QEP manual is currently being developed. We will notify you when it is available and posted on the Provider website.
