Dear Keystone First Primary Care Provider,

Keystone First is making the following changes to the Quality Enhancement Program (QEP) for the 2025 Program.

The Quality Performance Component will continue to consist of the following eight HEDIS® based measures:

- Child and Adolescent Well Care Visits [Total] (WCV)
- Asthma Medication Ratio
- Plan All Cause Readmission Count of Observed/Expected Ratio
- Well Child visits in the First 30 Months of Life (ages 0-15mo)
- Lead Screening for Children
- Controlling High Blood Pressure <140/90 mm Hg
- Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life
- Glycemic Status Assessment for Patients with Diabetes (GSD) (<9%)

Revised Program Components

- Minimum average panel of 50 or more members at the Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) level (rather than at the individual group level)
- Quarterly Total Cost of Care Component (this component will now apply to all types of practices/groups)

Existing Program Components expanded

• Health Equity Component for 3 quality metrics for Black American and Hispanic/Latino members

Removed Program Components

- Improvement Component
- Top Performer Component
